WAHLUKE SLOPE

The 2021 Jaine Rosé was crafted exclusively from the Ravenscliff Vineyards, a large vineyard parcel located on the Wahluke Slope of Washington State's Columbia Valley. The vineyard is fully sustainable, and the vines were machine-harvested early in the morning of August 26th and 27th, 2021. Upon arrival at the winery, the grapes were pressed to avoid minimal skin contact. The Grenache and Mourvèdre were combined and then fermented and aged entirely in stainless steel to maximize its aromatic potential, fruit esters and freshness. Over the course of 7 months, this wine was evaluated by the Jaine winemaking team, and finally bottled after filtration on March 17th, 2022. Only 2,000 cases were produced.

"A pale pink rosé with mineral-tinged, red fruit. This crisp, dry Provence-style wine shows aromas of citrus zest mingled with a delicate hint of honeysuckle blossoms and fresh herbs. On the palate, this wine offers bright flavors of grapefruit, strawberry, and mandarin."
