Matthews 2022 RESERVE CUVÉE



The 2022 Matthews Reserve Cuvée is comprised of several vineyard parcels within the greater Columbia Valley. Key sites are from Royal Slope (Solaksen, Scarline), Red Mountain (Quintessence, Red Mountain Vineyard, Two of Us Vineyard, Angela's Vineyard), and Horse Heaven Hills (Walulla Gap) allowing this wine to truly represent the broad flavor and aromatic expression of a Merlot-dominant blend from the diverse terroir of the Columbia Valley AVA.

The winemaking team worked with our vineyard managers to restrict yields, creating small, concentrated berries. Cool fall nights preserved freshness in the wine while continuing to develop flavor. Hand-harvesting took place in the early mornings in mid-October, and lasted into early November (a record for us).

At the winery, the fruit was destemmed and berry-sorted. Prior to fermentation, nearly 30% of volume was saignéed from tank to ensure maximum concentration across all varietals. Fermentations were kept even throughout primary, lasting an average of 14-17 days. Afterward, the wine spent an extra 2-3 weeks in tank for extended maceration before being barreled down into 100% new French oak (Darnajou, Taransaud, Gamba, Sylvain, Quintessence). The wine was cellared for 21 months with 38 barrels selected and carefully blended, resulting in only 950 cases. The wine was bottled unfined and unfiltered to preserve purity, vibrancy, and intensity.

The following clones were included in the final wine: Merlot 6, 181, 15, Cabernet Sauvignon: 2, 4, 191, 337, 8, Cabernet Franc 1, 214, 327, and Malbec clone 4.

"A rich Merlot-based, Pomerol-inspired blend with 18% Cabernet Franc, 13% Cabernet Sauvignon, and 8% Malbec, the 2022 Reserve Cuvée is textured with a velvety grip. Brooding black cherry cola presents as deeply concentrated and fullbodied, accented in dried herb, tobacco, leaf, and leathery saddle... The good bones show beautiful aging potential of 20-30 years."

....The entry is powerful and compact, delivering layers of wild blueberry, elderberry compote, and mission fig, interwoven with iron, clove, and charred rosemary. Tannins are grippy but polished, giving structure to the wine's muscular core. Hints of graphite, burnt orange peel, and baking spice add further complexity as the wine moves through a long, savory finish. Despite its depth and concentration, there's clarity and drive - each element feels carved and purposeful. This is a bold, age-worthy red blend that rewards patience, and while already compelling, it will reveal far greater nuance with a few more years in bottle. Highly recommended."
